MONTREAL (June 13, 2017) – TSN and the Montreal Canadiens announced today a comprehensive new regional broadcast rights agreement making TSN the official English-language broadcaster of the team beginning with the 2017-18 season. The new agreement sees TSN air a slate of games in the Montreal Canadiens' designated broadcast region, which spans Eastern and Northern Ontario, Québec, and Atlantic Canada. RDS continues to be the French-language home for Montreal Canadiens games.

[TSN 690](#) in Montréal also renewed its agreement with the Canadiens, maintaining full radio broadcast rights and further extending the station's position as the team's official English-language radio voice. TSN 690 provides exclusive live broadcast coverage of all pre-season, regular season, and playoff games for its listeners.

"It is with great pride that we welcome the Montreal Canadiens back to TSN with an expansive slate of marquee games," said Stewart Johnston, President, Bell Media Studios and TSN. "The addition of the Canadiens to our schedule broadens even further our strong NHL hockey offering and is yet another example of the breadth and depth of our programming roster."
