>> Michelle: THE 12-YEAR-OLD WAS TAKEN TO HOSPITAL WITH MINOR INJURIES.

MIKE WALKER JOINS US WITH THE DETAILS.

>> THE INCIDENT INVOLVING THE 12-YEAR-OLD BOY HAPPENED DURING THE LUNCH HOUR SUNDAY AFTERNOON.

WE'VE BEEN SPEAKING WITH SEVERAL PEOPLE WHO LIVE IN THIS RESIDENTIAL AREA AND THEY'VE HAD CLOSE ENCOUNTERS WITH THE COYOTE AS WELL EVEN IN THE DAYS BEFORE THAT ATTACK AND SOME PEOPLE HAVE SHARED SOME VIDEO WITH US.

TAKE A LOOK AT THIS.

IN THIS HOME SECURITY VIDEO CAPTURED THERE'S A MAN RUNNING AWAY FROM A COYOTE IN THE DRIVEWAY.

THIS HAND ON THURSDAY.

THE HOMEOWNER TELLS US HER HUSBAND MANAGED TO SAFELY RUN INTO THE HOUSE JUST IN TIME.

NEIGHBOURS HAVE ALSO SHARED SOME OTHER VIDEOS AND PICTURES WITH US OF THE COYOTE WALKING AROUND HERE.

RECENTLY THERE'S BEEN MULTIPLE SIGHTINGS.

SOME PEOPLE HAVE CROSSED PATHS WITH THE ANIMAL.

IN ONE CASE A SMALL DOG WAS ATTACKED AS WELL BUT THE OWNER TELL US IT DID NOT SUSTAIN SERIOUS INJURIES.

CHECKED OUT BY A VET AND IS OKAY.

MORE FROM AREA RESIDENTS.

>> MY SON-IN-LAW WAS PACKING OUT OF THE CAR AND THE COYOTE WAS A FEW FEET AWAY FROM HIM

AND HE TURNED AROUND.
HE THOUGHT IT WAS A DOG THAT
HAD GOTTEN OUT OF THE HOUSE BUT
IT WAS THE COYOTE AND IT WAS
PUSHING THROUGH PEOPLES' BLUE
BINS.

>> THEY COME OUT OF THE BUSHES
AND SEE AND WALK BACK IN.
I ALWAYS BRING A STICK TO
DEFEND MYSELF IN CASE THEY
ATTACK.

>> THIS IS REALLY SCARY.
IT MIGHT ATTACK.

THEY MIGHT BE HUNGRY.
THEY CAN TEAR YOU APART.

WHITE HOUSE ECONOMIC ADVISOR SAYS THE U.S. WILL RESTART TRADE NEGOTIATIONS WITH CANADA IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE CARNEY LIBERAL GOVERNMENT DROPPED THE DIGITAL SERVICES TAX.

THE BREAKING NEWS ON THE TAX BEING DROPPED CAME LAST NIGHT.

LET'S BRING IN COLTON PRAILL.

THE TIMING OF THIS MOVE IS INTERESTING BECAUSE THE FIRST PAYMENT OF THE DIGITAL SERVICES TAX WAS JUST ABOUT TO BE DUE FOR MAJOR TECH COMPANIES LIKE AMAZON AND GOOGLE BEFORE CANADA DROPPED IT.

IT WOULD HAVE BEEN A \$2.3 BILLION PAYMENT TO THE CANADIAN GOVERNMENT.

INSTEAD CANADA IS NOT ACCEPTING THE PAYMENT, WALKING BACK THE DST.

THAT'S GOING TO HAPPEN LATER. NOT GOING TO RECALL THE HOUSE OF COMMONS BECAUSE THAT'S WHAT'S NECESSARY TO KILL THIS LEGISLATION.

INSTEAD, JUST NOT COLLECT THE TAX PAYMENTS AND LATER ON THIS FALL THEY WILL ADDRESS THE DIGITAL SERVICES TAXATION.

WE'VE SEEN A TOTE REVERSAL.

FRIDAY TRUMP SAID HE WAS ENDING TRADE NEGOTIATIONS BECAUSE OF THIS TAX.

LAST NIGHT THE FINANCE MINISTER SAYS WE'RE MOVING AWAY FROM THIS AND TODAY WE'RE SEE THE NEGOTIATIONS HAVE RESTARTED. BOTH THE COMMENTS FROM THE WHITE HOUSE ECONOMIC ADVISOR AS WELL AS THE CANADIAN GOVERNMENT CONFIRMING THOSE ARE BACK ON

AND WORKING TOWARDS AS TRADE DEAL
IN PLACE BY JULY 21ST WHICH IS
THE 30-DAY TIME LINE SET OUT AT
THE G7.

AND BROUGHT UP WITH THE PRIME

PRIME MINISTER HAD A PHONE CALL
OVER THE WEEKEND AND SO TOO DID
THE FINANCE MINISTER AND THE
U.S. SECRETARY TREASURY.

WE DON'T KNOW THE NATURE OF THE
DISCUSSIONS BUT OBVIOUSLY AFTER
THOSE PHONE CALLS THE RELEASE
COMES OUT THAT EVEN AND THE BIG
CHANGE IS HAPPENING TODAY.

A REVERSAL OF CANADA'S POSITION
AND AN EASING OF A PAIN POINT.
