BUSINESS AFFAIRS DEVELOPMENT DELIVERABLES

PRE-DEVELOPMENT

The following documentation is required to be delivered to Business Affairs prior to execution of the development agreement between you and Bell Media.

- Signed Submission Form
- Development budget
- Development finance plan
- Details of any pre-existing contractual or financial commitments
- Copies of all chain of title documentation including assignments and underlying rights agreements, including but not limited to all writer agreements and option agreements
- List of key production personnel along with their CVs

DEVELOPMENT

Materials for delivery under development may be required on a case by case basis depending on the nature of the project. The following is a non-exhaustive list of deliverables and Bell Media reserves the right to require additional deliverables as may be required for the project:

Dramatic Series:

- Outline, First Draft, Second Draft, and Polish of a Script (Scripts can be pilot or episodic scripts)
- First Draft and Second Draft of the Bible
- Research Report
- Location Scouting Report
- Cast Report
- Final Cost Report

Documentary/Factual/Lifestyle:

- Treatment
- First Draft and Second Draft of the Series Overview
- Research Report
- Non-broadcast Demo
- Access Letter
- Final Cost Report

Digital Media Components:

- DM Budget
- DM Financing Plan
- First Draft and Second Draft of the Digital Media Concept Document
- Information Architecture and Wireframes
- Screen Comps

- Creative Brief
- User Experience Outline
- Technology Platform Requirements
- Prototype
- DM Final Cost Report

The development advance shall be payable upon receipt and approval by Bell Media of the above deliverables by way of the following payment schedule:

- 50% upon execution of the development agreement;
- 40% to be dispersed in various amounts according to each deliverable; and
- 10% upon final delivery materials.
